Care Instructions:

Your Heated Outdoor Cat House may be cleaned with a damp cloth when unplugged. The unit may be plugged in when the plug is thoroughly dry.

Do not place pad in confined area where the pet does not have the ability to remove themselves from the pad. Always allow your pet enough space to be able choose if they want to rest on the pad or off the pad.

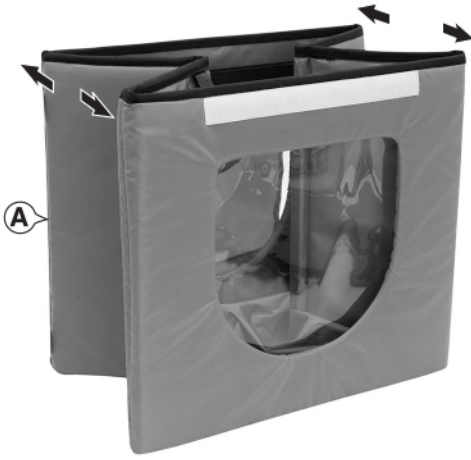
- To protect against electrical hazards, DO NOT immerse cord, plug, or appliance in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when used by or near children.

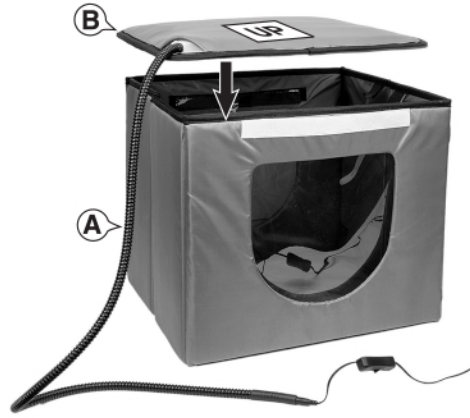
Step 1

Pull **Cube (A)** panels away from each other to create a cube.



Step 2

Place **Base (B)** inside **Cube (A)**.



Step 3

Place **Lid (C)** with the black hook and loop tabs side facing up (as shown below) on top of **Cube (A)**. Press firmly against hook and loop tabs for good adhesion.

A. Secure cord on inside seam using hook and loop tabs.

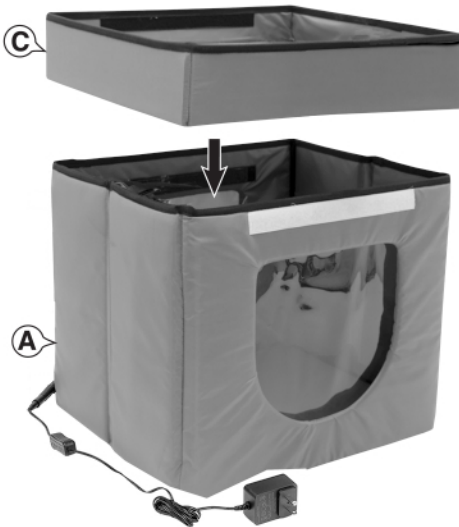


B. Place cord over the top of the cube.



Step 4

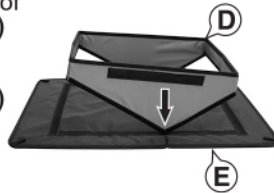
Place **Lid (C)** with the black hook and loop tabs side facing up (as shown below) on top of **Cube (A)**. Press firmly against hook and loop tabs for good adhesion.



Step 5

Place **Angled Cube (D)** down on top of **Ceiling (E)** to create **Roof (D&E)**.

A. Align short sides of **Angled Cube (D)** and **Ceiling (E)**. Line up peaks of **Angled Cube (D)** with fold line of **Ceiling (E)**.



B. Attach short side of **Angled Cube (D)** to short side of **Ceiling (E)** using hook and loop tabs. Press firmly.

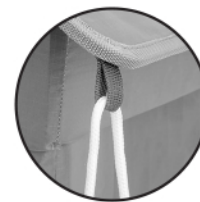
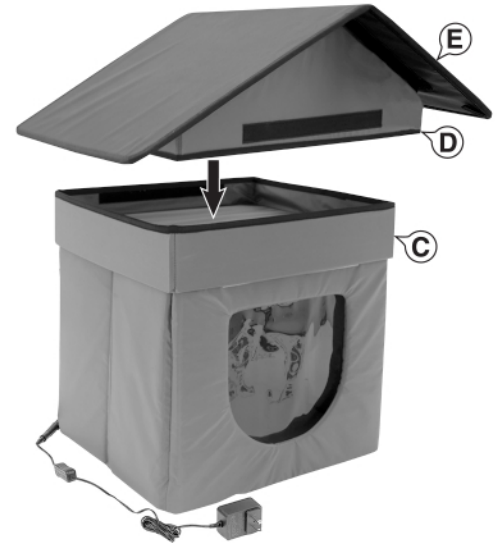


C. Attach long side of **Angled Cube (D)** to long side of **Ceiling (E)** using hook and loop tabs. Press firmly.



Last Step

Place **Roof (D&E)** inside **Lid (C)**. Press firmly against hook and loop tabs for good adhesion.



← The roof **Ceiling (E)** includes tie down loops for you to fasten the Heated Outside Cat House to the ground. **PURCHASE DOES NOT INCLUDE TIE DOWN STRING OR ANCHORS.**
